Tentative Schedule

- Date:** Session 1: May 28 - 31 for classroom work (Tues., Wed., Thur., Fri.)
Session 2: June 10 - 13 for classroom work (Mon., Tues., Wed., Thur.)
Driving sessions: June 3 – 7 and June 14 – July 3 (As many times as needed scheduled around your other activities). Those students that have an early June birthday (turning 16) may be assigned earlier driving times. Additional later dates can be scheduled as needed.
- Time:** Classroom work: 8:30 - 4:30. Driving times: 9:00 - 12:00 or 12:00 - 3:00 (3 people each session). Our instructor is certified to give the driving test.
- Cost:** \$225.00. **Fee is due at registration.**
- Registration:** April 1 - May 22. We limit each class to 18 students and it is **first come, first choice of sections**. Department of Public Safety (DPS) & State Department of Education (SDE) Driver's License Issuance

Information sheet for parent and parental permission form

THE STUDENT MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERION TO RECEIVE THE DRIVER'S LICENSE CERTIFICATE:

1. Have a valid Alabama learner's license.
2. Have a signed parental permission form on file in order to participate.
3. Successfully fulfill all the skill requirements as set forth by DPS and SDE.
4. Successfully complete Driver Education.

REMINDERS CONCERNING THE CERTIFICATES:

1. There will be no replacement certificates issued.
2. The certificate is not valid until the student turns sixteen years of age and has held a learner's license for at least six months.
3. Once the student turns sixteen and has held a learner's license for six months they may take the DPS/SDE certificate, along with their learner's license, to the DPS office (not the probate office) and obtain a driver's license.
4. The certificate cannot be laminated or altered in any manner.
5. Passing Driver Education does not guarantee that the student will receive the DPS/SDE driver's license certificate.
6. The certificate is not a valid document to use in lieu of a driver's license.
